CM APPL. 5488/2026 (seeking condonation of delay of 38 days in re-filing the petition)

1. For the grounds and reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the delay of 38 days in re-filing the petition is condoned.
2. Accordingly, the application stands disposed of.

W.P.(C) 1119/2026

3. Petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 (brothers) and Petitioner No. 3 (mother) of Late Ms. Anita Ghai applied for release of retiral benefits consequent upon the demise of Ms. Anita Ghai. While processing the Petitioners' request, the Respondent University, by its communication dated 16th September, 2025, informed the Petitioners that instead of the retiral dues being released, recovery is proposed to be effected on the ground that Ms. Anita Ghai had



allegedly concealed the fact that she was already in receipt of pension from Jesus and Mary College, Delhi, at the time of joining the Respondent University.

4. The Petitioners, on the other hand, contend that the case of Ms. Anita Ghai was one of fresh employment and, on that basis, dispute the proposed recovery.

5. Issue notice. Mr. Mohinder Rupal, counsel for the Respondent University, accepts notice.

6. Mr. Rupal submits that the copy of the paper-book supplied to him is incomplete and requests that a complete set be furnished. Counsel for the Petitioners undertakes to supply a complete copy to the Respondent University within a period of three days from today.

7. Counter affidavit be filed within a period of four weeks from today. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter.

8. Renotify on 23rd April, 2026.
