1. This application has been filed by the petitioner praying that the evidence of PW-3- Sh. Ramesh Nagpal be recorded by a Local Commissioner at his residence keeping in view his medical condition.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would not insist on the recording of the evidence at the residence of the said witness, as the said witness can come to the Court premises for recording of the evidence, but at the same time, the evidence be recorded by a Local Commissioner so as to ensure that it is expeditiously recorded.
3. The prayer made is not opposed by the learned counsels for the respondents.
4. I accordingly appoint Mr. O.P. Gupta, retired Additional District & Sessions Judge (Mob. No.9910384645) as a Local Commissioner to record the evidence of PW-3. The evidence be



recorded in the premises provided by the Delhi High Court Bar Association.

5. The fee of the learned Local Commissioner is fixed at Rs.33,000/- for the first three sittings, and thereafter, at the rate of Rs.11,000/- per sitting, to be borne by the petitioner apart from all other out-of-pocket expenses.

6. The parties shall appear before the learned Local Commissioner for recording of the evidence of PW-3 on 14.07.2023 at 2:00 PM.

7. The application is disposed of.
