1. Applicant seeks cancellation of anticipatory bail granted by learned Trial Court on 12.11.2025. It is contended that anticipatory bail has been granted to the accused/respondent No.2 herein while not appropriately considering the statement made by the victim under Section 164 Cr.P.C. It is submitted that there are two such statements and the second statement clearly indicts accused. It is also argued that there are allegations of threat also and, therefore, it was not a case where accused should have been enlarged on anticipatory bail.

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2. However, the first statement made by victim under Section 164 Cr.P.C. has not been placed on record.
