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1. File is placed before this Court vide order dated 13.03.2026 for recording the statement of the parties.
2. Petitioners seek quashing of case FIR No. 385/2022 of Police Station Ranhola for offence under Section 323/440/506/34 IPC on the ground that the respondent no. 2 (complainant de facto) has compromised the disputes with the petitioners.
3. As per the submissions, the matter between the petitioners and R-2 has been amicably settled. P-3 is appearing through virtual mode and vide separate submission made in this regard, he stated that he has settled the matter with the R-2.
4. Vide separate statement recorded in this behalf, P-1 and 2 stated that dispute between them and R-2 has been amicably settled as per the settlement deed dated 31.05.2025. The settlement has been arrived at between the parties herein without any force, coercion, undue influence and pressure. They have signed the settlement deed with their wish and will. Vide separate statement recorded in this behalf, R-



2 stated that dispute between K-2 and petitioners has been amicably settled as per the settlement deed dated 31.05.2025. The settlement has been arrived at between the parties herein without any force, coercion, undue influence and pressure. The settlement deed has been signed by the victim.

5. Investigating Officer is present in Court and has duly verified the identity of both the parties. Separate statement of Investigating Officer has also been recorded.

6. The parties along with their counsels have confirmed that the settlement deed has been duly entered into between them.

7. The compromise/settlement deed is in writing and has been duly signed by both the parties. I have heard both the parties and from the direct dialogue with both the parties, it is observed that the consent of both the parties is found to be genuine and has not been obtained under undue influence or pressure.

8. Since statements of the parties have been recorded, matter be placed before the Hon'ble Court on 29.04.2026.

9. Date is given as per the request made by the counsels for the parties.
