1. On the basis of complaint filed by the petitioner herein, FIR No. 33/2019 dated 15.02.2019 was registered at Police Station Naraina for commission of offences under Sections 498A/406/506/377/354/509/34 IPC.
2. Charge-sheet was filed and *vide* order dated 22.01.2025, respondent no. 2 (husband), respondent no. 3 (brother-in-law) and respondent no. 4 (mother-in-law) were directed to be charged and when aforesaid order on charge was challenged by the aforesaid respondents, they have been discharged for some of such offences. The following table would depict the same:-

Respondent No. 2 (Husband)	Section 377/498A/406 IPC	Section 498A/406 IPC
Respondent No. 3 (Brother-in-law)	Section 354/498A IPC	Section 498-A IPC
Respondent No. 4 (Mother-in-law)	Section 498A IPC	Section 498A IPC

3. It is in the aforesaid premise that present petition has been filed.
4. According to learned counsel for petitioner, since there were specific allegations relatable to cruelty, none of the accused should have been discharged for the aforesaid offences by the learned Court of Sessions.
5. Learned Addl. P.P. for State/R-1 appears on advance notice and accepts notice and seeks time to file reply.
6. Let reply be filed by next date of hearing with advance copy to opposite side.
7. Notice be also issued to remaining respondents through all permissible modes, including *dasti* as also through counsel.
