6. The present Review Petition has been filed by the Petitioners seeking review of order dated 25.03.2026, whereby the present Petition was dismissed while upholding the order dated 07.01.2025 passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal.



7. In substance, the Petitioners claim that they have obtained qualifying marks in the Subordinate Accounts Service Examination held in the year 2018, however, they have not been promoted.

8. Admittedly, it is not the case of the Petitioners that the candidates who have obtained lesser marks than the Petitioners have been promoted to the post of Assistant Accounts Officer.

9. In such circumstances, no error apparent on the face of the record is made out warranting review of the order dated 25.03.2026.

10. The present Review Petition is accordingly dismissed.
