I.A. 17851/2022 (Delay)

1. This is an application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, 1963 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (hereinafter "CPC") for condonation of delay in filing the I.A. 17850/2022 under Order XXII Rule 4 of CPC.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of defendants no. 1 to 3 has objection to the same, however, he did not file any objection yet. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of defendant no. 4 (i), (ii) and (iii) has no objection to the same
