1. These applications have been filed by the appellant seeking condonation of 161 days' delay in filing of the appeal and 77 days' delay in re-filing of the present appeal.
2. It is contended that the appellant is a senior citizen suffering from various deceases, that is, urinary tract infection, old cerebrovascular Accident, seizure disorder, old carcinoma breast, type-2 diabetes Mellitus, Hypertension. The appellant also got her surgery done on 16.09.2024, and got discharged on 24.09.2024.
3. Though the learned counsels for the respondents oppose these applications, we find that the applications are also supported by the medical documents of the appellant. We, therefore, find that the appellant has been able to make out sufficient cause for condonation

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of delay in filing as well as in re-filing the appeal.

4. Accordingly, the applications are allowed.

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5. Issue notice.

6. Notice is accepted by Ms.Kanika Agnihotri, learned counsel on behalf of respondent no.1 and Mr.Arjun Mukherjee, learned counsel on behalf of respondent no.2.

7. Let reply to the appeal be filed by the respondents within a period of four weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a period of two weeks thereafter.
