Vide this application, plaintiff has sought permission to place on record certain documents which he filed along with his rejoinder to the earlier application IA No. 2574/2016.

In the said IA No. 2574/2016, the plaintiff had sought the placing on record of one document only. However, in the rejoinder to this IA, he had submitted a list of documents seeking permission to place on record those documents as well. This Court however declined the request of the plaintiff to place on record the documents accompanying his rejoinder while allowing his IA No. 2574/2016. Now, the plaintiff has moved this application to place on record those documents.

Learned counsel for the defendant has submitted that he has no objection if the plaintiff be permitted to place on record those documents, subject to heavy cost because the plaintiff is bringing on

record the documents in piecemeal and thereby delaying the disposal of the matter.

In view of the no objection on behalf of the learned counsel for the defendant and in the interest of justice, plaintiff is permitted to place on record the documents which were mentioned in the additional list filed by it along with the rejoinder to his IA No. 2574/2016.

The fact that this IA No. 2574/2016 was also for permission to file documents on record and in that application, the plaintiff did not seek permission to place all those documents also, list of which was submitted by him along with his rejoinder to that application, thereby approaching the Court for the same relief in piecemeal, while allowing the application, I impose a cost of Rs. 20,000/-upon the plaintiff.

Since the documents are already on record, the matter be listed before the Joint Registrar on 25.04.2017 for admission/denial of these documents.
