Vide this application, appellant is seeking release of fixed deposit receipt of Rs.50,000/- which was deposited in the Registry of this Court in compliance of order dated 27th September, 2019 of this Court in Crl.M.A. 34933/2019.

Learned counsel for appellant submits that vide order of 27th September, 2019 in Crl.M.A. 34933/2019, this court had permitted the appellant to travel abroad on certain conditions and in compliance thereof, appellant had deposited security amount of Rs.50,000/- in the form of fixed deposit receipt with the Registry of this Court and had also
