File has been placed before me in compliance of orders dated 27.03.2023 and 21.03.2022 vide which the appellant has been granted permission to travel abroad by the Hon'ble Court subject to the conditions contained in the said order.

In compliance of orders dated 27.03.2023 and 21.03.2022 passed by the Hon'ble Court, appellant has filed an affidavit whereby she has undertaken that she shall abide by the terms contained in the orders dated 27.03.2023 and 21.03.2022. She has filed an affidavit furnishing the address of her stay during her visit to abroad. The appellant has also furnished in the affidavit that in her absence she will be represent by her counsel and her counsel is authorised to make statements on her behalf. She has also undertaken that she will inform the Court within 48 hours of her return from abroad and adhere to her schedule and shall not extend her stay.

The appellant shall be travelling w.e.f. 01.05.2023 to 28.06.2023. The appellant is present in person. She has been duly



identified by her counsel. Appellant affirms that she has signed the affidavit filed before this Court, the details are true and correct and has also undertaken to be bound and abide by all the conditions imposed by the Hon'ble Court for her travel abroad by orders dated 27.03.2023 and 21.03.2022.

The Hon'ble Court vide orders dated 27.03.2023 and 21.03.2022 also directed to furnish the security in the amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- in the form of FDR to the Registrar General of this Court. She has handed over the two FDRs of Rs.50,000/- each across the board bearing nos. 614700PU00015443 and 614700PU00015452 drawn on Punjab National Bank dated 29.03.2023. The same are taken on record. Concerned Deputy Registrar/Assistant Registrar of registry is directed to keep the FDRs in safe custody till further orders.

Registry shall also send an intimation to the concerned bank not to encash the amount of FDRs to anyone without prior permission of this Court.

Considering that the conditions have been complied with by the appellant, she may travel, as permitted by the Hon'ble Court vide orders dated 27.03.2023 and 21.03.2022.
