File has been placed before me in compliance of order dated 23.03.2026. Petitioner i.e. Ms. P M Singh has been granted permission to travel abroad from 16.05.2026 to 22.05.2026 (UK) and from 22.05.2026 to 17.08.2026 (USA) by the Hon'ble Court subject to conditions contained in order dated 23.03.2026.

In compliance of order dated 23.03.2026 passed by the Hon'ble Court, petitioner has filed an affidavit-cum-undertaking whereby she has undertaken that she shall abide by the terms contained in the affidavit. She has mentioned the complete itinerary including her stay at residential addresses. She has undertaken that she will not oppose in any manner to the proceedings to be carried out in my absences and shall be represented through her counsel.

Vide order dated 23.03.2026 the Hon'ble Court has directed the petitioner to furnish the security of Rs. 05 Lakh.



Today, in compliance of order dated 23.03.2026 petitioner has also furnished the FDR for Rs. 5,00,000/-. The original FDR bearing A/c No. 614700DP00009771 revalidated on 23.03.2026 till 10.06.2027 for an amount of Rs. 5,00,000/- is handed over across the board. The same are taken on record. The dealing shall keep the same in safe custody till further orders.

For verification of FDR Mr. Rahul Sharma having employee ID 5205151 from Punjab National Bank has joined proceedings through video conferencing and has verified the above FDR.

Registry is directed to keep the FDRs on record till further orders. The FDRs is found in order and the same are hereby accepted. Registry is directed to send the intimation to the Bank that the said FDR shall not be encashed by the bank without prior permission of this Court.

Besides, the petitioner has also furnished a copy of the air tickets that she has purchased for her travel.

The petitioner is present in Court. She has been duly identified by her counsel. Petitioner affirms that she has signed the undertaking filed before this Court, the details of travel, contact furnished in the Court are true and correct and has also undertaken to be bound by the terms of undertaking and to abide by all the conditions imposed by the Hon'ble Court for her travel abroad by order dated 23.03.2026.

Petitioner is directed that she shall intimate the Court about her return to India within 48 hours of her return and shall deposit her passport to the Court.

Petitioner is directed that she shall intimate in writing to the Investigating Officer about the date when she wants to leave abroad and the date she will return back.



Petitioner is directed to adhere to her schedule and would not extend her stay.

Considering that the conditions have been complied with by the petitioner, she may travel, as permitted by the Hon'ble Court vide order dated 23.03.2026.
