Heard. Request allowed.

The applications are for permission to travel abroad from 20.10.2019 to 30.12.2019.

Ld. Counsel for the CBI opposes the same. However, perusal of the record reveals that permission has been granted several times earlier. Therefore, keeping in mind the above facts, permission is granted to the applicant to travel abroad to USA between 20.10.2019

to 30.12.2019 on her complying with the following conditions:-

(1) That she shall furnish her address where she would stay during the visit abroad;

(2) That she shall also furnish the security to the tune of Rs. 50,000/- in the shape of FDR;

(3) That the applicant shall also file the affidavit to the effect that she shall not oppose in any manner the proceedings to be carried out in her absence and she shall be represented through her counsel;

(4) That the accused/applicant shall inform to the court about her return to Indian within 48 hours of her return and shall deposit her passport in the court.

(5) That the accused/applicant will adhere to her schedule and would not extend her stay.

Both the applications are, thus, disposed off.

A copy of this order be given *dasti* to the learned counsel for the petitioner under the signature of the court master.

Earlier date i.e. 14.10.2019 stands cancelled.
