This is an application filed by the respondent praying for vacation of the interim order dated 12.07.2018. Learned counsel for the respondent /applicant submits that despite directions of this Court, the appellant has not cleared the arrears of mesne profits and therefore prays that the order granting stay to the appellant be vacated.

Notice in the present application was issued vide order dated 12.04.2019. The appellant has till date, neither filed any reply nor has been able to give any explanation as to why the arrears of mesne profits have not been deposited by the appellant.

Proxy counsel for the appellant prays for one last opportunity to file reply/get instructions. Even though the request is opposed by learned counsel for the respondent, one last opportunity of two weeks is granted to the appellant to file reply, failing which the Court will be



compelled to vacate the stay order. Rejoinder, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter.
