1. This petition is filed for the following reliefs:

“a. To issue a wrtt in the nature of mandamus or any other writ/ writs, order/ orders, direction/ directions, kindly be allowed and Quash the FIR i.e., FIR No 0202 Of 2023 dated 25th April 2023 under section 135 & 138 of Indian Electricity Act Amended 2003 police station Mandawati Fazalpur District: East pending for disposal before 763 Additional Session Judge [East] Karkardooma] Delhi quash the petitioner in view of payment of electricity as raised by the respondent was duly mad~ by the petitioner and the same was duly accepted by the respondents”
