ORDER

I.A. 2472/2019

1. The present I.A. has been filed by Plaintiff No.1 seeking reference to mediation. Defendant No.1 has no objection and Plaintiff No.2 submits that



he will seek instructions for participating in the mediation. I.A. is disposed of with the direction that the matter be sent to Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre for exploring amicable resolution of the disputes between Plaintiffs and Defendant No.1.

2. List before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre on 27th February, 2019.

CS(OS) 2139/2014 & I.A.s 2755/2016, 8156/2016 (delay)

3. Pursuant to the last order, Ld. counsel for the Airport Authority of India (*hereinafter* 'AAI') submits that AAI is not the authority which has the data relating to international travels. In fact, it is the Immigration Department which would have the details of persons who travel internationally. Accordingly, Mr. S. Dayal, GM (Law) who is present in Court, is discharged from further appearance.

4. The Ld. Proxy Counsel appearing for the CGSC on behalf of the UOI, submits that he has no instructions as to which is the authority that collects and maintains the data relating to international travel of passengers. Accordingly, it is directed that the Joint Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs to submit the data as directed in order dated 11th October, 2018 of the travel details of Late Sh. Harbhajan Singh VEDI, pursuant to his Passport bearing no. Z2182419 for the period 1st January, 2013 till 31st December, 2015.

5. The details be provided in a sealed cover within four weeks, failing which, the Joint Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs concerned with the Immigration Department shall be present in Court on the next date of hearing.

6. A fresh counsel has been engaged on behalf of Petitioner No.1. On behalf of Petitioner No.2, it is submitted that earlier a Power of Attorney had



been given to Plaintiff No.1 by Plaintiff No.2 for pursuing this litigation. However, the said Power of Attorney stands revoked. The counsel for Plaintiff No.2 submits that he would be filing a fresh *vakalatnama* within two weeks.

7. Insofar as the investigation in respect of withdrawal of money from the account of Late Sh. Harbhajan Singh Vedi is concerned, status report has again been filed by Assistant Commissioner of Police, EOW Cell, New Delhi which shows that various forged documents have been used for opening of bank accounts and also for withdrawing the said amounts. Inspector Dharmendra Kumar Singh who is present in Court submits that the investigation is still going on and it would require at least two months' time. It is directed that the investigation would proceed on an expeditious basis and be concluded as soon as possible.

8. List for further reporting on the status of investigation on 26th April, 2019.

9. If the parties are aware of any further facts and documents, they are permitted to intimate the same to the Investigating Officer.
