Crl.M.B.1654/2016 (Suspension of Sentence)

Appellant has been convicted under Section 21(c) of NDPS Act by the trial court and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 10 years with fine of ₹1,00,000/- and in default of payment of fine to undergo simple imprisonment for six months. Appellant has completed sentence of more than five years. Disposal of appeal is likely to take time.

Keeping in mind the totality of facts and circumstances, sentence of appellant is suspended during pendency of appeal, subject to his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of ₹25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of trial court.

Application is disposed of in the above terms. Dasti.
