1. The present application has been filed on behalf of the Petitioner under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking recall of the order dated 06.03.2024, by which the W.P.(C) 6671/2007 was dismissed for non-prosecution, and for its restoration to the original number.
2. Learned counsel for the Respondent submits that the writ petition was dismissed in default on 3rd December, 2015 and was restored on 22nd January, 2019. Thereafter, there was repeated non-appearance on behalf of the Petitioner on 27th July, 2022; 7th September, 2022; 15th December, 2022; and 18th July, 2023. On 1st November, 2023, learned counsel for the Petitioner sought time on the ground of recent engagement. However, on 6th March, 2024, taking note of the repeated non-appearance, this Court dismissed the petition for non-prosecution. It is further submitted that even



thereafter, on certain dates, none appeared on behalf of the Petitioner.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner seeks an adjournment on the ground that the arguing counsel is unwell today.

4. Considering the personal ground urged on behalf of learned counsel for the Petitioner, a last and final opportunity is granted to address arguments on the application.
