CRL.M.A. 35341/2018 (Exemption)

Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

The application stands disposed off.

CRL.M.A. 35340/2018 (for release of expenditure)

The applicant seeks monies for meeting expenses for applying to the British High Commission, New Delhi for renewal/issuance of a new passport to her son. The application fee is stated to be about UK Pound 85 i.e. about Rs.10,000/-. Since the applicant is out on bail for 10 days, she would have to incur incidental expenses too. Accordingly, it is directed that Rs.25,000/- for the renewal of passport and Rs.10,000/- for other incidental expenses be released to her from the monies deposited with Registrar



General of this Court vide order dated 30.10.2017.

The application is disposed off in the above terms.

CRL.M.A. 35339/2018 (for handing over original affidavit)

The applicant seeks handing over of the original affidavit filed by the petitioner to the effect that he has no objection to the issuance of a renewed passport or a new to his son - master Aryan Kapur. Let the same be released to the applicant after a certified copy of the same has been retained in the record. The said original affidavit shall be submitted with the British High Commission, New Delhi along with an application for issuance of a valid passport to the applicant's son.

Mr. Rana, the learned counsel for the applicant further submits that the application may well not be accepted by the British High Commission or its authorized agency unless a certified copy of the father's passport is annexed along with the aforesaid application. In the circumstances, the non-applicant/ petitioner is directed to supply to the applicant a copy of his passport along with his two passport size photographs so that the request for a valid passport for Master Aryan Kapur could be processed.

The application is disposed off in the above terms.
