Vide this application, applicant/second respondent has prayed for a direction to be issued to the petitioner to pay the fee of the child.

Learned counsel for second respondent/complainant submits that there are outstanding dues to the tune of Rs.45,500/- towards transport and meal charges, which are to be paid to the school.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner has deposited a sum of Rs.90,000/- with the school three days ago and arrears, if any, shall be also cleared within a week.

Learned counsel for second respondent further submits that

petitioner be directed to ensure that the school fee along with transport and meal expenses etc. of the child is paid from time to time, so that second respondent should not be required to file such application time and again.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner has no access to the communication made to the parents by the school towards fee etc., but in all fairness, petitioner is ready to bear the school fee including transport and meal expenses provided he is duly informed.

Learned counsel for second respondent submits that respondent has no objection if the petitioner is allowed to have access to communication made by the school regarding payment of fee etc.

In view of the above, the petitioner shall ensure that school fee of the child is paid in time for whole of the session.

With aforesaid directions, this application stands disposed of accordingly.
