1. Petitioner impugns Order on Charge dated 08.02.2018, whereby the petitioner has been charged with having committed an offence under Section 306 Indian Penal Code (IPC).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the Trial Court has discussed certain statements recorded by the prosecution during investigation, however, at best the said allegations amount to cruelty and do not satisfy the requirements of Section 306 IPC, which



pertained to abetting and forcing someone to commit suicide. It is submitted that the Trial Court has referred to the fact that there is telephonic conversation between the petitioner and the deceased just before the suicide was committed, however, it has also noticed that the content of the conversation has not been established and as such, there is no material to show that the petitioner instigated or abetted the deceased to commit suicide.

3. Issue notice. Notice is accepted by the learned counsel for the Additional Public Prosecutor for the State, who prays for time to file status report.

4. Let the status report be filed within four weeks.

5. List for consideration on 08th August, 2018.

6. Since the next date before the Trial Court is 22.05.2018, the Trial Court Record be requisitioned after 22.05.2018, digitized, scanned and tagged along with the file of this Court and thereafter transmitted back to the Trial Court forthwith.
