ORDER

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1. By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks setting aside of the impugned order dated 08.02.2018, passed by the learned ASJ-02, (South-West), Dwarka Courts whereby the charges have been framed in FIR No. 308/2016 dated 16.04.2016 registered at PS.: Bindapur, Delhi, under *Sections 306/34* of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has apprised this Court that as many as *fifteen* witnesses out of total of *nineteen* witnesses have already been examined before the learned Trial Court, and since remaining



witnesses are only formal witnesses, the trial is likely to be concluded soon. As such, he submits that the present petition may be disposed of with a direction to the learned Trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously.

3. Learned APP for the State submits that he has no objection if the present is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

4. Considering the aforesaid, learned Trial Court is requested to conclude the trial arising out of FIR No. 308/2016 dated 16.04.2016 registered at PS.: Bindapur, Delhi, under *Sections 306/34 IPC* as expeditiously as possible, preferably on or before 31.03.2027, *albeit*, subject to the daily cause list and overall pendency.

5. Needless to say, none of the parties shall be allowed to take any unnecessary adjournment(s) during the completion of the said time period.

6. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
