On behalf of the respondent it is submitted by learned counsel for the respondent that there has been no compliance of the direction dated 1.3.2017 for payment of litigation expenses to the respondent by way of a cheque in the name of respondent to be delivered to the counsel for the respondent for which counsel for the petitioner submits that the cheque was sought to be handed over to the respondent but the same was not accepted by the respondent and thereafter the same was sent to the respondent through post.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that a cheque bearing No.073746 in the name of the respondent dated 14.3.2017 drawn on Syndicate Bank for a sum of Rs.15,000/- was sent to the respondent. However, the said cheque is no more valid. Litigation expenses in the sum of Rs.15,000/- by way of a cheque in the name of the respondent be handed over to the respondent in Court on the next date.
