CRL.M.A. 9166/2026 (*Delay 25 days*)

1. By virtue of the present application under *Section 528* of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the petitioners seek condonation of delay of *25 days* in filing the restoration application for the captioned petition.

2. Though specific reasons have not been stated therein, however, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to rely upon the medical condition of the father of two petitioners, which are appended alongwith the application being CRL.M.A. 9165/2026, seeking restoration of the present revision petition.

3. In light of the aforesaid, the present application is allowed and the delay of *25 days* in filing the restoration application for the captioned petition is condoned.

4. The present application is disposed of.

5. By virtue of the present application, the petitioners seek restoration of the captioned petition.

6. Although the petitioners were not represented on as many as four occasions and they were enjoying the stay granted by this Court *vide* order dated 24.07.2018, however, in view of the order passed in CRL.M.A. 9166/2026 hereinabove and considering the nature of assertions as also the documents appended alongwith the present application, particularly, since the old father of two petitioners is involved, the present application is allowed and the present petition is restored to its original position, *albeit* subject to costs of Rs.25,000/- to be paid by the petitioners to the Delhi High Court Bar Association Lawyers Social Security and Welfare Fund [A/C 155530100009730; IFSC UCBA0001553] within a period of *two weeks*.

7. The present application is disposed of.

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8. Upon the petitioners taking requisite steps within a period of *one week*, issue notice to the respondent no.2 by all permissible modes, returnable on 19.08.2026.

9. Considering that the interim order dated 24.07.2018 was continuing till the dismissal of the present petition on 27.01.2026, the same is also restored.

10. As such, renotify on 19.08.2026.

11. Interim order(s) to continue till the next date of hearing.
