1. Pleadings are already complete qua defendant no.1&2.

2. As per record, physical copy of the documents filed by the plaintiff, defendant no.1 and defendant no.2, are already on record.

3. Further, revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by plaintiff qua documents of defendant no.1&2 and revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by defendant no.1 qua documents of the plaintiff are already on record

3. At this stage, it is stated by learned counsel for the defendant no.2 that he has re-filed his revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents qua documents of the plaintiff yesterday but the same is not on record. He seeks one more opportunity to bring the same on record. Opposed. Vide order dated 03.09.2024, learned counsel for the defendant no.2 was directed to take requisite steps to



bring the same on record but till date, no steps have been taken by defendant no.2 for which no plausible explanation is furnished by defendant no.2. So, cost of Rs.4000/- is imposed upon defendant no.2 to be paid to the plaintiff and now, last and final opportunity is granted to the defendant no.2 to take requisite steps to bring the revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents as per law.

4. The defendant no.2 is directed to pay the cost imposed today to learned counsel for the plaintiff within ten days.

5. Thereafter, the plaintiff is directed to share draft of Joint Schedule of the documents with learned counsels for the defendants within two weeks. Learned respective counsel for defendant no.1 and defendant no.2 are directed to provide their inputs, if any, to the draft of Joint Schedule of the documents to learned counsel for the plaintiff within one week thereafter. The plaintiff is directed to file soft copy as well as physical copy of Joint Schedule of the documents within one week thereafter with copy to the opposite side.

Re-notify the matter for marking of exhibits to the documents on 04.03.2025.
