1. Pleadings are already complete qua defendant no.1&2.
2. As per record, physical copy of the documents filed by the plaintiff, defendant no.1 and defendant no.2, are already on record.
3. Further, revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by plaintiff qua documents of defendant no.1&2 and revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by defendant no.1 qua documents of the plaintiff are already on record
4. It is stated by parties that previous cost of Rs.4000/- has already been paid by the defendant no.2 to the plaintiff.
5. As per office note, revised Admission/Denial Affidavit filed by defendant no.2 is now on record.
6. However, on perusal of the revised Affidavits of the parties, it is found that revised respective Affidavits filed by plaintiff and defendant no.2 are again not in the



prescribed format. It is unfortunate to observe herein that counsels are filing Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents without applying the relevant law. In this view of the matter, cost of Rs.7000/- each is imposed upon the plaintiff and defendant no.2 to be deposited with Advocate's Welfare Fund and now the last and final opportunity is granted to both plaintiff and defendant no.2 to file fresh/revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents strictly as per law within three weeks with copy to the opposite side.

7. Thereafter, the plaintiff is directed to share draft of Joint Schedule of the documents as compatible with revised Affidavits of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by the parties with learned counsels for the defendants within two weeks. Learned respective counsel for defendant no.1 and defendant no.2 are directed to either provide their inputs, if any, to the draft of Joint Schedule of the documents or to provide the signed copy of Joint Schedule of the documents to learned counsel for the plaintiff within one week thereafter. The plaintiff is directed to file soft copy as well as physical copy of Joint Schedule of the documents within one week thereafter with copy to the opposite side.

Re-notify the matter for marking of exhibits to the documents on 26.05.2025.
