Brief Notes/Synopsis:-

This matter was adjourned till further order with a direction not to list in the category of 'Regulars'.

The matter was taken up under the category of 'adjourned sine die matters' in furtherance of abovementioned circular on 13.02.2026.

In this matter, the appeal was filed by the appellant Ramesh against his conviction and sentence in FIR No. 325/2006, PS Old Delhi Railway Station. Thereafter, the appellant failed to appear despite issuance of bailable and non-bailable warrants, which remained unexecuted. Thereafter, vide order dated 18.04.2023, the matter was ordered to be sent to the learned Trial Court to conduct proceedings in accordance with law.



Inspector Ajay Kumar on behalf of SHO Bijay Kumar, PS ODRS appeared and filed the report and same is taken on record.
