1. The instant application has been filed by the applicant i.e. appellant /insurance company for waiver of cost imposed by the Predecessor Bench of this Court *vide* order dated 24th April, 2023.
2. It is submitted that since the file of the instant appeal has been misplaced in his office, he could not file the written submissions within the prescribed time as per directions of this Court.
3. It is submitted that filing of the written submissions after expiry of the time period assigned by the Court was not intentional but due to bonafide reasons. It is prayed that the cost of Rs.10,000/- payable to each of the respondents may be waived off for due to reasons stated herein.
4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent fairly



conceded that she has no objection on allowing the instant application.

5. Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties and perused the contents of the instant application. This Court finds sufficient/cogent reasons for allowing the instant application.

6. For the sufficient cause being shown by the learned counsel for the applicant, this Court allows the instant application. Costs imposed by the Predecessor Bench of this Court vide order dated 24th April, 2023 is waived off.

7. Accordingly, the application is disposed of.
