1. The present case for partition, declaration and permanent injunction was registered as suit vide order of Hon'ble Court dated 01.06.2018. It is the case of the plaintiff that he is the eldest son of Late Sh. Umesh Chandra and is entitled to one fourth share in properties of his deceased father. The parties in the suit are siblings and their father died intestate. The immovable properties left behind by late Sh. Umesh Chandra is mentioned in paragraph 6 of the plaint.
2. Plaintiff was granted ex-parte injunction on 01.06.2018 and issues were framed on 27.11.2018 after completion of pleadings. Ld. Local Commissioner was appointed vide order dated 23.05.2019 for recording of evidence.
3. On 02.02.2024, IA No.3405/2023 was filed by plaintiff seeking the suit to be consigned sine die till disposal of
