1. Issue notice.
2. Learned respective counsels for the non-applicants accept notice of the above-captioned IA.
3. Let reply, if any, to the above-captioned IA be filed by non-applicant within two weeks with copy to the opposite side, who shall be at liberty to file rejoinder, if any, within two weeks thereafter with copy to the opposite side.
4. Re-notify the captioned IA for completion of pleadings on the next date of hearing.

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5. The defendant no.2 has not filed the proof of cost of Rs.10,000/-, as directed to be deposited with Advocate's



Welfare Fund till date. At this stage, it is submitted by learned counsel for the defendant no.2 that he shall seek instruction qua payment of the said cost from defendant no.2. Let proof of the said cost be filed by the defendant no.2 with the Registry before the next date of hearing.

6. As per office note, e-copy of Evidence by way of Affidavits of three witnesses filed by the defendant no.1 are still lying under objections. Learned counsel for the defendant no.1 submits that IA no.15541/2025 has been filed for condonation of delay in filing of the said Evidence Affidavits.

7. At this stage, learned counsel for the defendant no.2 submits that he shall cross-examine DW1/Mr. Ashok Chopra after the Evidence Affidavits of other Part-C witnesses will come on record. Opposed by learned counsel for defendant no.1 on the ground that the said Evidence Affidavits do not have any relation with cross-examination of the witness present in the Court.

8. In light of the previous order dated 23.11.2024, the matter is adjourned for today.

9. Re-notify the matter for further proceedings on 21.11.2025.
