1. The matter is listed today for further cross-examination of DW1/Mr. Ashok Kumar Chopra on behalf of defendant no. 2, who is present in the Court today.
2. As per office note, physical copies of Evidence by way of Affidavits of DW/Ms. Reena, DW/Mr. Gurdip & DW/Mr. Sandeep have been filed on behalf of defendant no. 1.
