1. The petitioner seeks suspension of sentence till disposal of the revision petition.
2. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have examined the file. The petitioner was convicted under Sections 279/304 A IPC and was sentenced to undergo RI for one month under Section 279 IPC and SI for eight months under Section 304A IPC. Nominal roll dated 09.05.2017 reveals that he has already undergone one month and twenty-three days incarceration besides remission for two days as on 08.05.2017. Nominal roll further reveals that he is not a previous convict and his overall jail conduct is satisfactory. The revision petition is not likely to be heard in near future.

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3. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the remaining period of substantive sentence of the petitioner is suspended till the disposal of the revision petition on furnishing personal bond in the sum of ₹ 30,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

4. The bail application stands disposed of.
