1. The petitioners allege contempt of an order dated 12.03.2013, passed by the learned Single Judge of this Court in W.P.(C) 1240/2010. It is undisputed that an appeal against the said judgment is pending before the Division Bench in L.P.A. 926/2013.

2. The parties have drawn my attention to various orders passed by the Division Bench requiring the respondents herein to continue to make payment of arrears of pay due to the petitioners, *albeit* in installments. Learned counsel for the respondents states that payments are being made in terms of the orders of the Division Bench.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners disputes this position and states that since April, 2019, three of the petitioners herein have not been paid any

amount. It is contended on behalf of the respondents that this position has come about because the entire arrears of those three petitioners have already been cleared.

4. While the ultimate fate of these proceedings will be subject to the decision of the Division Bench, having regard to the orders that have been passed during the pendency of the appeal, and to expedite these proceedings, it would be appropriate if the parties file affidavits detailing the computations which according to them are in accordance with the orders of the learned Single Judge and the interim orders passed in the appeal. The respondents shall file an affidavit to this effect within four weeks and the petitioners may file their response thereto within four weeks thereafter.

5. If the Letters Patent Appeal is disposed of by the Division Bench in the meantime, the petitioners may move an application for early hearing.
