This application has been filed by the plaintiff with the following prayers:

“In the facts and circumstances, it is most respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to:

(a) vacate the restraining order passed by this Hon'ble Court on 31.05.2018 in so far as property at L-93-94, Shiv Mandir Marg, Block- L, Lajpat Nagar-II, New Delhi is concerned; and

(b) pass such other or further order as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case and in the interest of justice.”

It is the submission Mr. Sujoy Kumar, learned counsel appearing for the plaintiff that the property in question being L-93/94, Shiv Mandir Marg, Block-L, Lajpat Nagar-II, New Delhi does not concern the defendant Pramod Chadha. According to him, it is the case of mistaken identity and, in fact, this aspect has been clarified by the learned Joint Registrar in his

order dated January 10, 2020. Accordingly, the prayer has prayed for is granted and the stay order dated May 31, 2018 shall not read qua property No. L-93/94, Shiv Mandir Marg, Block-L, Lagpat Nagar-II, New Delhi.

Application stands disposed of.
