1. This application is allowed with the consent order that plaintiff will pay a sum of Rs.11,000/- to the counsels for the defendant nos. 4 and 5 and who also appears for the proposed defendants. Costs be paid within for weeks from today.

6. List this matter before the Joint Registrar for marking of exhibits to the documents and for completion of pleadings on 22nd February, 2018. The Joint Registrar will, after completion of pleadings, list the matter in Court for framing of issues.
