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1. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the survey which had been carried out by the MCD has not been completed.
2. It seems that the last status report filed by the MCD, which is on record, is dated 26.05.2023. The said status report states that two agencies are appointed for conducting surveys of street vendors and “that survey will be completed by the empanelled agencies for which the timeline has been extended upto 30.09.2023”.
3. The learned counsel appearing for respondent no. 2/North Delhi Municipal Corporation (‘NDMC’), was asked as to what is the current stage of the survey and whether the same has been carried out by the said agencies. However, he seeks time to obtain instructions.
4. According to the petitioner, Weekly Sunday Market (Kabbadi



Bazaar/Vellodrome market) is a heritage market as defined in Clause (zb) (viii) of the Second Schedule of the Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014. It is stated that the market was shifted to another location, however, the same is now required to be relocated at an opposite place.

5. MCD shall respond to the status of the said market and possible steps required for relocation of the said market.
6. Let fresh status report be filed before the next date of hearing.
7. List on 19.03.2025.
