Mr. Prashant Bhushan, learned counsel for the petitioners states that after the vendors who had been participating in the Sunday weekly Kabadi Bazaar held at Subhash Marg were removed from the said site, they had approached the Minister of Home, Health, Power, PWD, Industries and Urban Development, GNCTD who had convened a meeting to discuss the proposals for relocating the said vendors on 07.10.2019. We are informed that a meeting did take place on 07.10.2019 and another meeting is scheduled on 21.10.2019. Perusal of the notice dated
