The learned counsel for the petitioners have placed reliance on the documents, that is, the Ration Cards, Kerosene Oil Cards and Voter Identity Cards in support of the claim of the petitioner nos.1 to 5 that they were residing in the Basti Kushak Nallah which were demolished in the year 2009. Placing reliance on the order dated 19.02.2010 issued by the Principal Secretary (UD), Government of NCT of Delhi, he submits that the cut of date for determining the eligibility was 31.12.1998 and the abovementioned documents are proof of such occupation of the jhuggi holders on the date as set out in the said order. The petitioners duly qualify the eligibility conditions as set out in the said Order and therefore, were entitled to rehabilitation.

The learned counsel for the respondent no.3 prays for time to examine

the matter.

The respondents shall file an additional affidavit clearly explaining its stand on the documents that have been filed by the petitioners. In case of inquiry by the respondent no.3, the other authorities would render their assistance to the respondent no.3.
