1. This application has been filed on behalf of the registered trade union of workers employed in *Eastern Medikit Ltd.* (company in liquidation), alleging that they have dues amounting to *Rs.90.70 crores*. No money has been paid to them, and hardships have been caused to families of the workmen.

2. *Mr. Sangram Pattnaik*, counsel appearing on behalf of applicant, states that there has been massive siphoning of funds and fraud in relation to the company. The Ex-directors have launched their own company and are manufacturing the same products which were earlier manufactured by the company in liquidation. Therefore, he presses *prayer clause (b)* of the



application seeking appointment of Serious Fraud Investigation Office (“*SFIO*”) or an independent agency to investigate the affairs of the past and present Directors.

3. Issue Notice.
4. *Mr. Nishi Ranjan Singh, Adv.* for Ex-directors, accepts Notice and seeks time to file a response.
5. *Mr. Manik Dogra, Senior Counsel* for Ex-directors, however, states that earlier applications filed on behalf of other trade unions are pending, and this application need not be separately entertained. He seeks to place the relevant aspects on record. Same may be filed within the next four weeks.
6. *Mr. D. Bhattacharya*, counsel for Official Liquidator (*‘OL’*), will place note on status of the company as well as the list of pending applications.
7. List on 13<sup>th</sup> April 2026.
