CM APPL. 47350/2025 (for deletion of petitioner No. 11)

1. This application has been filed by petitioner No. 11 seeking deletion from the array of parties on the ground that he has settled the disputes with respondent Nos. 3 and 4 herein (Delhi Jain Public School).
2. Petitioner No. 11 – K.M.P. Yadav, is present in Court, and Ms. Sunita Panwar, Principal, Delhi Jain Public School, is also present in Court.
3. A copy of the Memorandum of Understanding dated 10.07.2025 has been placed on record, which provides that he would be paid an amount of Rs. 6.5 lakhs in satisfaction of all his dues. An amount of Rs. 3.50 lakhs has already been paid to him, and the balance of Rs. 3 lakhs is



tendered to him in Court today by Mr. Onkar Prasad, learned counsel for the School.

4. In view of the above, the application is allowed, and the name of petitioner No. 11 is deleted from the array of parties. Amended memo of parties be filed within one week.

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1. Mr. Onkar Prasad submits that the School has also entered into settlement with some of the other petitioners, namely petitioner Nos. 8, 9, and 12. Mr. V.N. Jha, learned counsel for the petitioners, however, submits that he has no instructions in this regard. However, he submits that he will take instructions and file appropriate applications on behalf of any petitioners who have already settled the disputes.

2. As far as the other petitioners are concerned, learned counsel for the parties request that the matters may be referred to mediation, so that mutually acceptable settlements can be worked out in their case also.

3. Having regard to this submission, the petitioners, who have not yet been able to settle the matter, and the respondent – School are referred to mediation under the aegis of *Samadhan*, Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Shershah Road, New Delhi-110503.

4. They shall appear before the learned Mediator on 18.08.2025.

5. List before the Court on the date already fixed, i.e., 24.09.2025.
