1. The learned counsel for the Official Liquidator has drawn my attention to the Report No. 134 of 2015 wherein, *inter alia*, the following prayer was made:

“3. Commissioner of Customs, Inland Container Depot, Tughlakabad, New Delhi – 110020 may be directed to refund the Custom duty amounting Rs. 55,48,988/- already paid for the 2 auctioned containers mentioned in Para 10 of this report.”

2. She submits that the Container Corporation of India Limited (in short, ‘the CONCOR’) and the Customs Authorities were to file their response to the same within a period of four weeks. She submits that no such response has been filed so far by the Customs Authorities.



3. Further, drawing reference to the Order dated 31.03.2016 passed in C.A. No. 2451 of 2015, she submits that the CONCOR was to deposit the amount forfeited from the auction purchaser with the Official Liquidator. The CONCOR, however, has not made any such deposit nor has given details of the amounts.

4. Accordingly, let notice be issued to the CONCOR and the Customs Authorities, through their respective Standing Counsels, returnable on 18th November, 2022.

CO.APPL. 2112/2016

5. The learned counsel for the Official Liquidator submits that this application has been rendered infructuous in view of the OLR 286 of 2018.

6. As none appears for the applicant, the application is disposed of, granting liberty to the applicant to revive the same in case it is felt necessary.

OLR 98/2016

7. The learned counsel for the Official Liquidator submits that the present OLR has been rendered infructuous.

8. Accordingly, the OLR is disposed of.

OLR 300/2019

9. The learned counsel for the Official Liquidator submits that the OLR has become infructuous and the same is disposed
