ORDER

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28.01.2025

1. It is pointed out that the Deputy Commissioner (Customs) who was present in Court through video conference on 30.11.2023 had undertaken to remit the sum of ₹55,48,988/- into the Official Liquidator's account.
2. The learned Standing Counsel for the Official Liquidator submits that the said amount has still not been remitted even though the email in that regard was written way back on 04.12.2023.
3. He submits that the reminder email was also sent on



15.01.2024.

4. *Prima facie*, the conduct of the officer of the Customs Authorities is contempt of Court. However, last opportunity is granted to transfer the amount as directed by order dated 04.10.2023 and undertaken by the concerned officer as noted in order dated 30.11.2023 within a period of three working days.

5. In case the said amount is not transferred, the concerned officer is directed to remain present in Court in person on the next date of hearing.
