CM APPL. 23179/2024 (On behalf of respondent no.1 for clarification of judgment dated 14.02.2024.)

1. This is an application filed on behalf of applicant/respondent no.2 under Section 151 CPC, 1908 seeking clarification of the judgment dated 14.02.2024.

2. Mr. Jha, learned counsel appearing for the non-applicant/petitioner submits that as per the judgment passed by this Court, the non-applicant / petitioner was entitled to benefit three years prior to the filing of the writ petition.

3. According to Mr. Gupta, the writ petition was filed on 18.11.2011 which would automatically entitle the non-applicant/petitioner to arrears w.e.f.18.11.2008 till 17.11.2011. He

submits that the issue is not clearly specified in the judgment dated 14.02.2024, hence the present application was necessitated.

4. Issue notice.

5. Notice is accepted by Mr. Jha, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner who seeks and is granted four weeks to file the reply with an advance copy to learned counsel for the non-applicant /respondent. Rejoinder, thereto if any, be filed within four weeks, thereafter, with an advance copy to learned counsel for the non-applicant/petitioner.

6. Mr. Jha submits that in the meanwhile the applicant/respondent may be directed to release the arrears of that part which is not disputed rather admitted.
