1. This is an application filed by the petitioner seeking early hearing of the writ petition.
2. Even though no ground is made out for early hearing as the matter is already listed on 16.11.2022, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on account of the reasons set out in the application, the petitioner is facing grave financial hardship and is not even able to meet the expenses of his own medical treatment and that of his ailing wife and son.
3. In the light of the aforesaid, the petitioner is granted liberty to submit a representation to the respondent within a period of one week seeking grant of compassionate allowance and/or any other financial assistance which may be permissible as per the rules. In case such a representation is made, the respondent will consider the same within a

period of four weeks from today. It is expected that while considering the petitioner's representation, the respondent will act compassionately and will take into account extreme financial difficulties being faced by the petitioner.

4. The application is, accordingly, disposed of.
