IA No.3815/2022 u/O XXII R 4A CPC moved by respondent no.2 for deleting the name of deceased respondents i.e. Rajender Singh Negi and Manmohan Singh Negi from the array of parties

Perusal of records shows that Sh. Rajender Singh Negi and Sh. Manmohan Singh Negi were previously brought on record as LR's of late Smt. Joginder Kaur vide order dated 28.01.2021.

Both the said respondents i.e. Sh. Rajender Singh Negi and Sh. Manmohan Singh Negi have expired on 01.06.2021 and 07.06.2021 respectively. Death certificates of deceased are on record. It is stated in the captioned IA that Sh. Rajender Singh Negi died leaving behind his two daughters, who are already on record as respondents, being LR's of late Smt. Joginder Kaur. Similarly, it is stated that Sh. Manmohan Singh Negi has not left behind any Class I heir and his Class II LR's being sisters are already on record as respondents being LR's of late Smt. Joginder Kaur.

Today learned counsel for petitioner is present and submits that

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without prejudice to his rights and contentions, petitioner has no objection to the captioned IA.

Accordingly, the captioned IA stands allowed to the extent that the factum of death of Sh. Rajender Singh Negi and Sh. Manmohan Singh Negi is taken on record. Amended memo of parties be filed by petitioner within one week. Amended memo of parties in terms of directions vide order dated 28.01.2021, if not filed earlier, be filed within one week. Accordingly, the captioned IA stands disposed of.
