Learned counsel for LR no. (iv) enters appearance and accepts notice. He undertakes to file vakalatnama within one week. He submits that he has no objection if the applications are allowed.

Learned counsel for LR no. (ii, iii, v) submits that he has no objection if the applications are allowed.

LR no. (i) is also present in Court in person and submits that he has no objection if the applications are allowed.



For the reason stated in the application seeking condonation of delay, the same is allowed and delay in filing CM No. 20259/2025 is condoned. Application bearing CM No. 20260/2025 is disposed of.
