1. The file is taken up today on office note.
2. As per office noting, the summons issued to witness no. 4 remained unserved. Though in the order dated 18.08.2026, it has been recorded that witness no. 4 has been served and therefore bailable warrants were issued against him.
3. Since, as per the latest office note, the witness no. 4 remained unserved. Therefore, the order of issuing the bailable warrants against witness no. 4 is recalled.
4. Ld. Counsel for respondent no. 2 submits that he has already taken the steps for issuance of summons to other witnesses in terms of order dated 18.08.2026.
5. Issue fresh summons to witness no. 4 through all permissible modes on taking appropriate steps by respondent no. 2.
6. Re-notify the matter for recording of evidence of the summoned witnesses on behalf of respondent no. 2 on the



date already fixed i.e. **18th November, 2026** and for recording of evidence of respondent no.2 on **19th November, 2026**.
