ORDER
13.01.2025

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1. The petitioner was hitherto represented by Ms. Ankita Patnaik, Advocate, nominated by the Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee. The petitioner is present in person, and states that she has since engaged Mr. Vikas Kumar, learned counsel, privately and does not seek legal aid. Mr. Kumar is also present through video conferencing. He states that he has already filed his vakalatnama. In view of this submission, Ms. Patnaik's request for discharge is granted.

2. By order dated 26.11.2024, serious allegations of forgery of documents against the petitioner, were referred for investigation and forensic examination to the Special Cell, Delhi Police. The Deputy



Commissioner of Police (Special Cell) [“DCP”] was directed to furnish his report in a sealed cover within five weeks.

3. Learned counsel for the Special Cell states that investigation is at an advanced stage, and certain inquiries have been made with Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, to which no response has been received. Learned counsel for Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital states that the Hospital will respond to the inquiries of the Special Cell within a period of two weeks.

4. Mr. Kumar states that if the petitioner wishes to submit any original documents to the Special Cell, she will do so within a period of seven days from today.

5. The DCP is directed to furnish his report in terms of the order dated 26.11.2024, within two weeks thereafter, in a sealed cover. The DCP will consider the documents furnished by the petitioner, if any, also at the time of formulating the report.

6. It appears that the petitioner has filed a bundle of several documents on 02.12.2024 in the Registry of this Court. The documents have been sent to the Court by the Registry in a sealed cover. The documents are not supported by any affidavit. Documents filed in this manner cannot be taken on record. If the petitioner wishes to file any documents before the Court, she is at liberty to place an additional affidavit within one week.
