Plaintiff be directed to take fresh steps for the service of defendants 2, 3, 5 & 6 on furnishing the fresh address, if any, or old address on filing of PF, RC, Speed post and through approved courier including dasti.

Steps be taken within two weeks time

Parties concerned be directed to carry admission/denial through an affidavit be filed within two weeks time and copies thereof be exchanged.



Renotify this matter on 12.04.2017 for appearance of defendants 2, 3, 5 & 6, completion of pleadings and admission/denial.
