Mr. Chhibber, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has not drafted the present petition and on perusing the same has noticed some deficiencies relating to the grounds taken in the petition to challenge an order dated 09.05.2017, whereby the findings and sentence of the General Security Force Court (GSFC) were confirmed by the respondent No.3 in respect of the petitioner and the subsequent orders dated 20.02.2018 and 03.03.2018, whereby the post confirmation petition of the petitioner has been rejected by the respondents. Learned counsel reserves his right to move an application to amend the writ petition.

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2. He however requests that there is an urgency insofar as the interim application for suspension of sentence is concerned for the reasons that the period of punishment of imprisonment for three years, imposed on the petitioner apart from his dismissal from service, is likely to expire in the first week of October, 2018.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents is directed to obtain necessary instructions from the Department in the light of the averments made by the petitioner in CM No.31938/2018, particularly para 12 thereof and revert back.
